Kassandra Flinterhoff (1989) explores and experiments with the harmonious combination of organic shapes and colours reinterpreted through layers and textures that speak to the soul. Under the title 'Bee Vibrant,' we are exhibiting fourteen works with the titles 'Bountiful Supplies,' 'Summer Symphony,' 'Beautiful Fragility,' 'Sun Dance,' 'Sweet Spot,' 'Orange Bloom,' 'Rooted in Light,' 'Time is Running,' 'Honey Paradise,' 'A Feast for Bees,' 'The Life of a Lemon,' 'Ascending,' 'Bee Vibrant,' and 'Boom Boom Pow - Nature is Wow,' where she expresses her belief that transformations and cycles are always present, not only in nature, but also in ourselves. Every detail, every experience is part of a greater whole that is only revealed over time. Her mixed and multi-layered works on canvas are a reflection of the vitality, harmony and diversity of nature.

She works with airbrush, collage, sand and luminous acrylic and oil colours, creating organic abstractions and semi-realistic motifs that invite a dialogue about beauty, fragility and balance.

Kassandra Flinterhoff (born in 1989 in Zittau, raised in Krumbach, Bavaria) is a German artist who lives and works in Valencia. In early 2025, she opened her own studio in the historic fishing district of Cabanyal. In 2023/24, he completed the annual Mastery programme at the Milan Art Institute (USA), where he developed his distinctive visual language. His vibrant mixed-media works combine semi-realistic motifs with organic abstractions and capture the beauty, light and colours of nature.

In 2025, she presented *Valencia Vibrante* at the Escorxador Cultural Centre. Since 2024, she has been exhibiting at Galerie Munk in Bavaria. Her works are part of international private collections and invite the viewer to rediscover nature in all its vitality.
